"They converse about the world and people, who are like big fires, little fires and fires of all colours; and they dialogue with speech and also with their bodies in space", the artists explain.

"Natanam" means dance in Sanskrit, and this is the starting point of the show: "To give early-childhood audiences a place and moment for sensations through the purity of dance".
